Objective:

The primary objective of this coaching session was to equip B.Tech 3rd and 4th-year students with a comprehensive understanding of the GATE (Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering) examination. The session aimed to:

- Familiarize students with the exam pattern and mark distribution.
- Provide in-depth knowledge on key subjects: Computer Organization (CO) and Design and Analysis of Algorithms (DAA).
- Enhance students' problem-solving abilities and time management skills through a mock test.

Session Overview:

- **Conceptual Clarity:** The session enhanced students' grasp of CO and DAA topics, which are essential for GATE preparation.
- **Time Management Skills:** The mock test allowed students to assess their speed and accuracy, highlighting areas for improvement.
- **Self-Evaluation:** Post-test discussions helped students analyze their performance and focus on weak areas.
- **Strategic Preparation:** Students were provided with study tips, recommended resources, and problem-solving techniques to improve their preparation.
