Key Activities Conducted:

Inauguration & Village Survey (Day 1):



- The camp commenced with an inaugural event in Patha Korangi.
- A detailed **village survey** was conducted by dividing volunteers into teams.
- Focused on age group 15-29: collecting data on education status, employment, and skill levels.
- The survey provided the baseline for planning developmental interventions.

Environmental Initiatives (Day 2):

- **Plantation Drive:** Over 40 saplings planted by volunteers to promote environmental sustainability.
- Save Soil Awareness Campaign: Educated villagers on soil conservation, sustainable farming, and reducing plastic use. Slogans in Telugu were used for effective local communication.



Cleanliness and Social Awareness (Day 3):

- Swachh Bharat Campaign: Village clean-up activity executed by all volunteers.
- Women Empowerment Workshop: Focused on social, economic, and political empowerment; promoted equality and rights awareness.















Health & Nutrition (Day 4):

- **Medical Camp:** Conducted with support from a local Pharmacy College. Services included:
 - o Blood pressure, sugar, and blood grouping tests.
- Food Scarcity Awareness: Rally and campaigns emphasized reducing food waste and understanding hunger issues.

Child Welfare & Education (Day 5):

- **School Interaction:** Volunteers distributed books and stationery; organized games and awareness sessions.
- Child Labour Awareness Rally: Slogans and street plays highlighted the importance of education and eradication of child labour.
